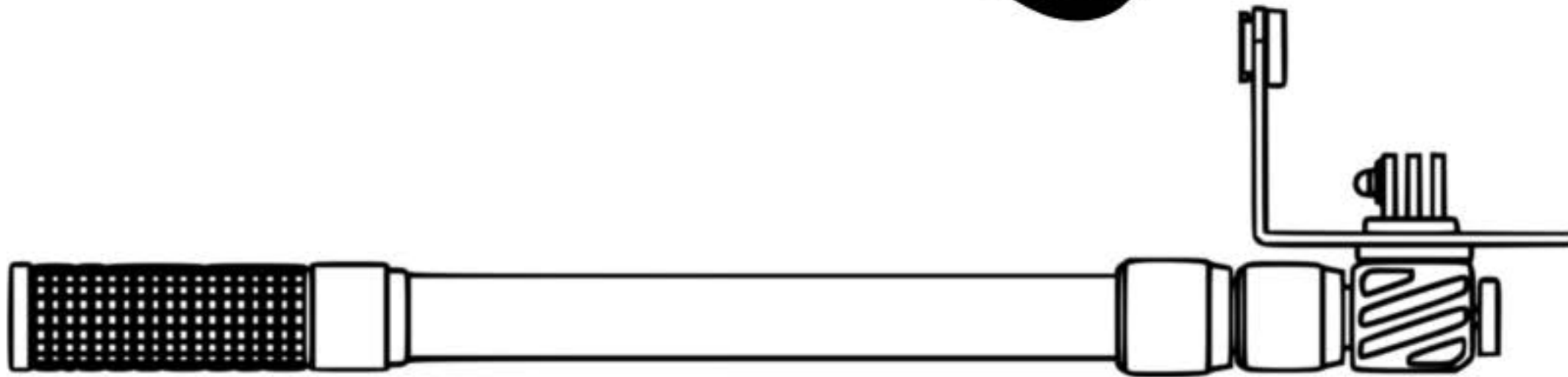

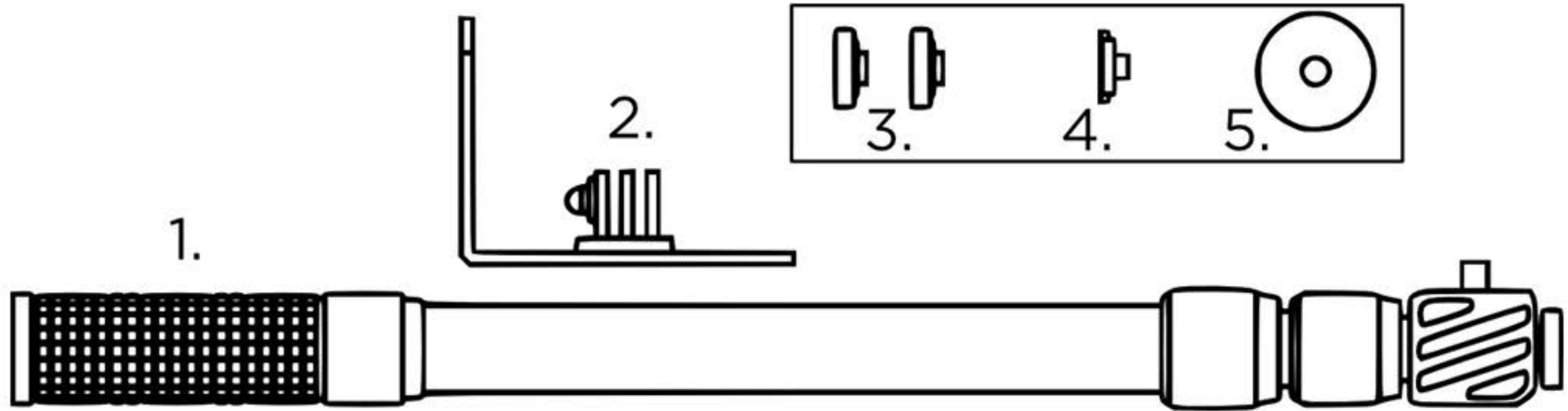

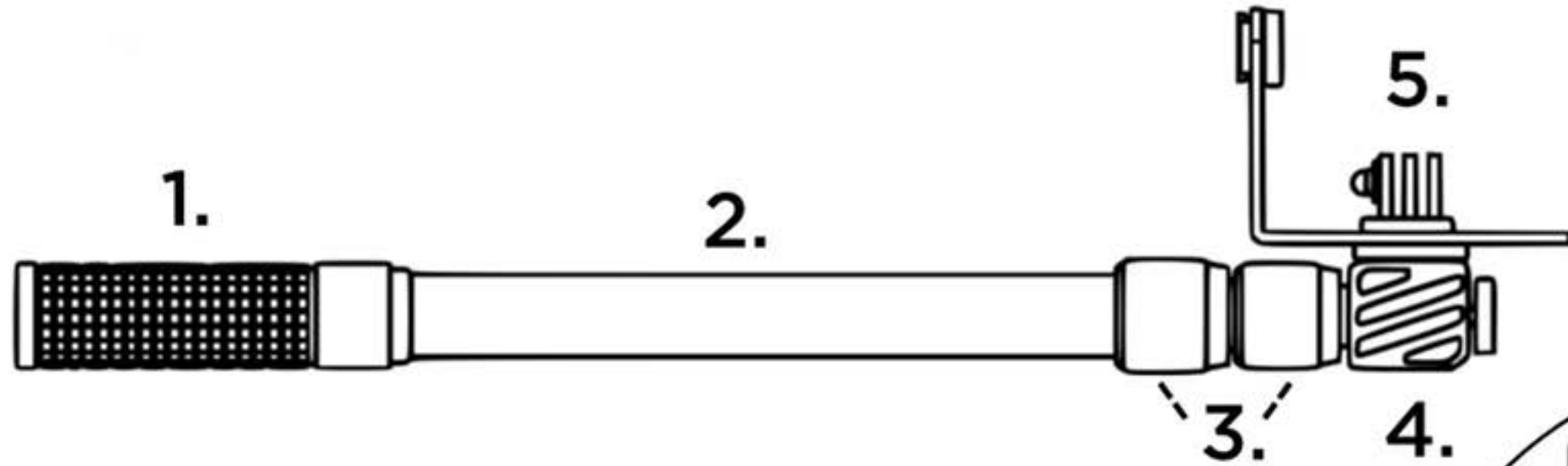
1. MicroJib main body

5. Locking Nut



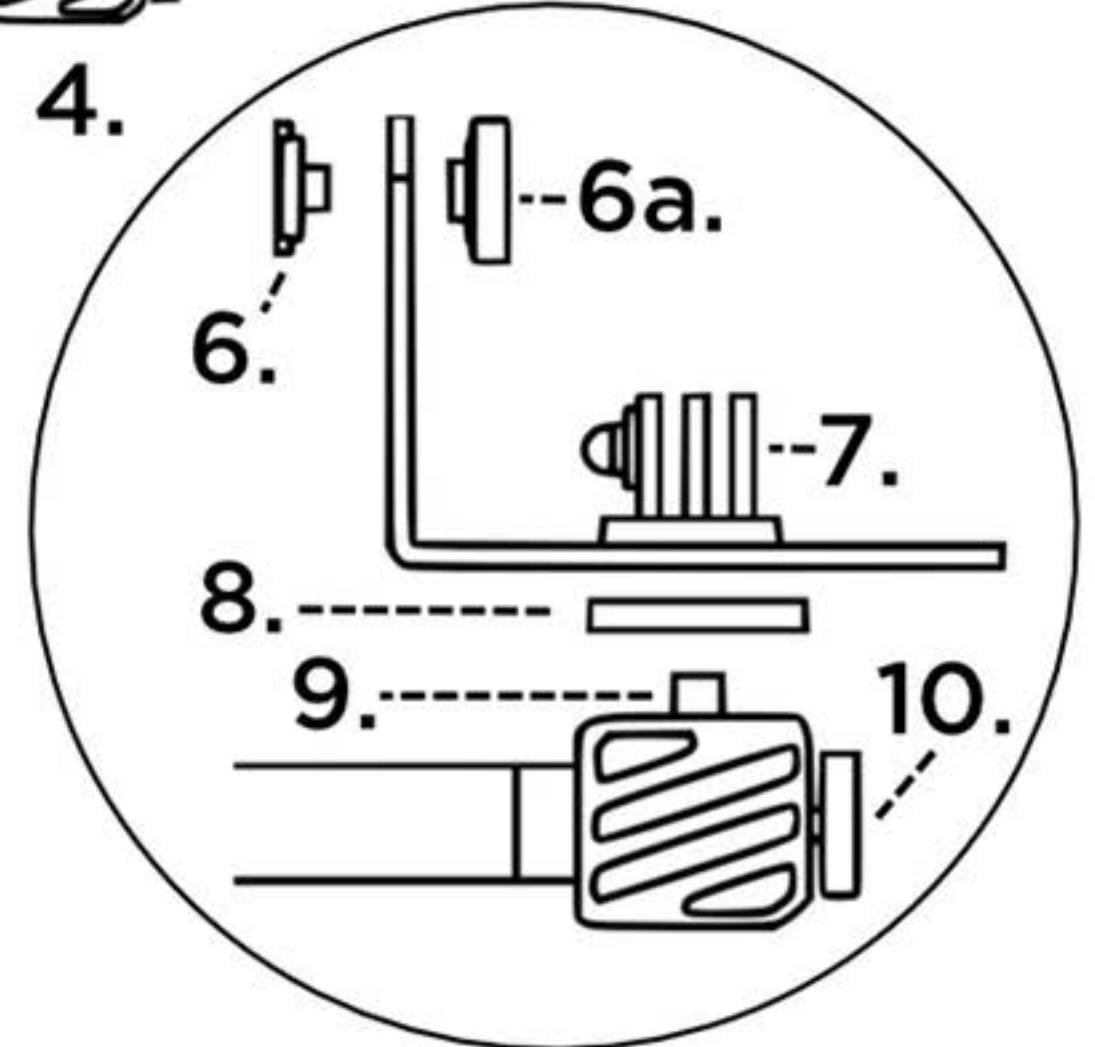

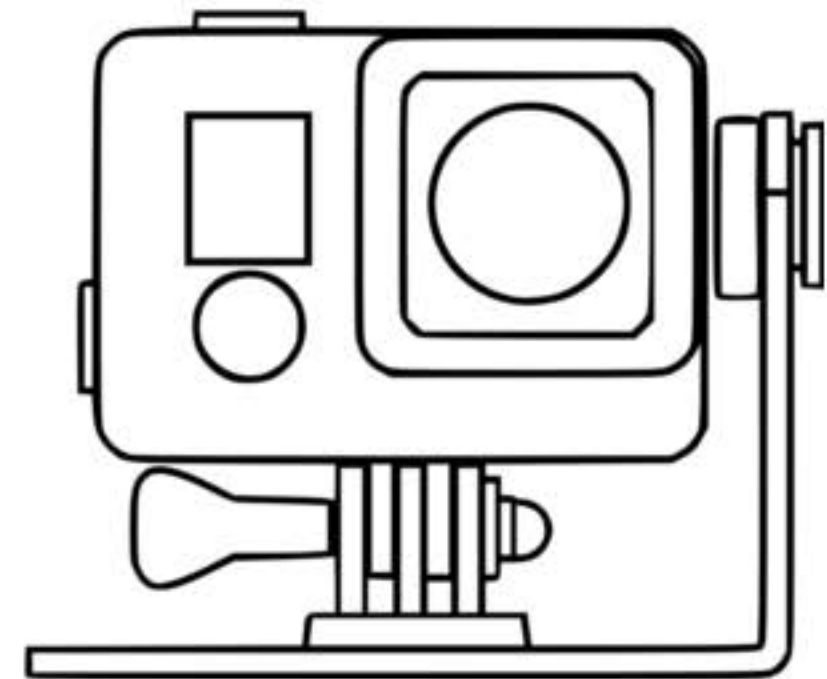
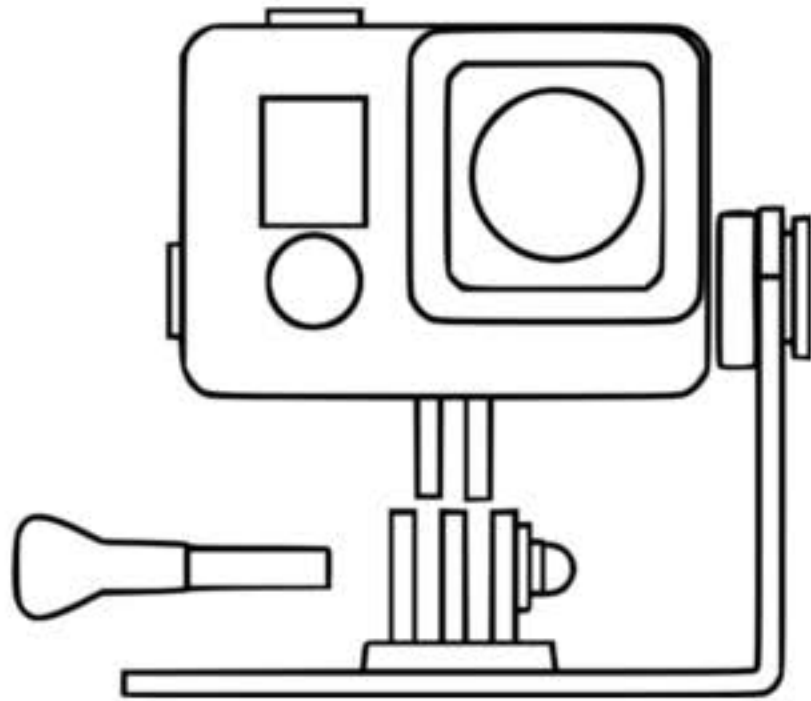


Quick Start Guide



Please use diagram on left for reference to components

1. Mounting Camera



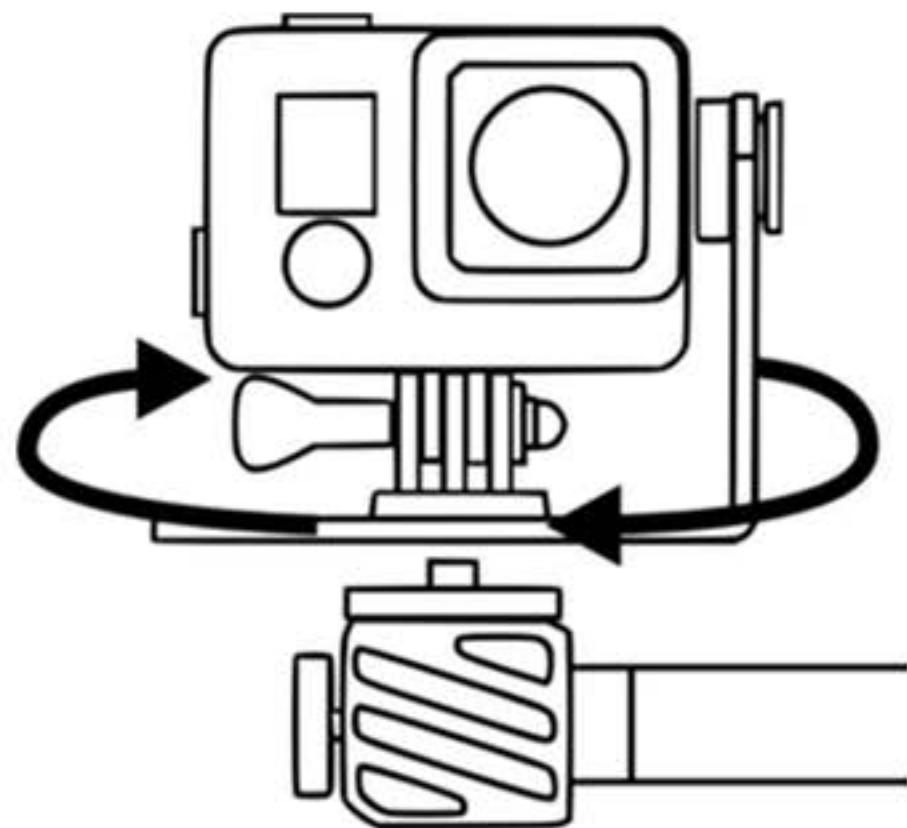
1. Align camera so wifi button is on open side of L-Bracket. Use Image above for reference.

2. Attach camera using a GoPro™ thumb screw (*not included*) and tighten until camera is secure onto L-Bracket.

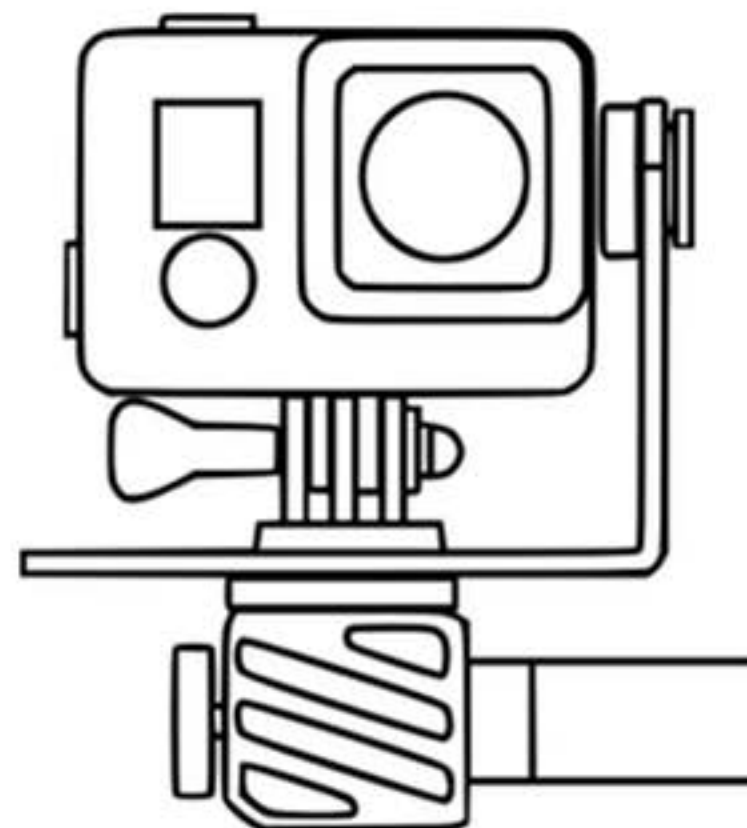

2. Panning Setup



1. Orient camera parallel to shaft. Rotate L-Bracket clockwise on to gear shaft until contact is made with locking nut.

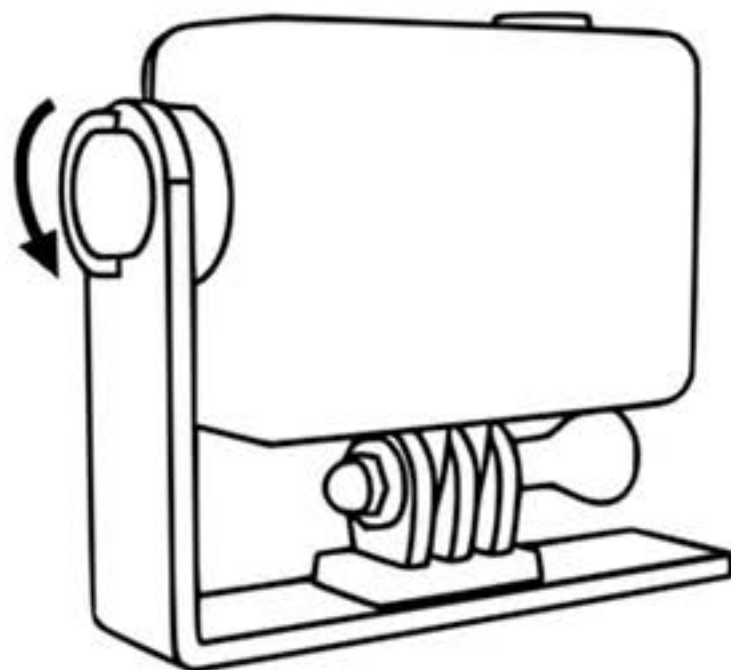


2. Turn locking nut counter-clockwise while holding L-Bracket steady until camera is firmly mounted on to gear shaft.

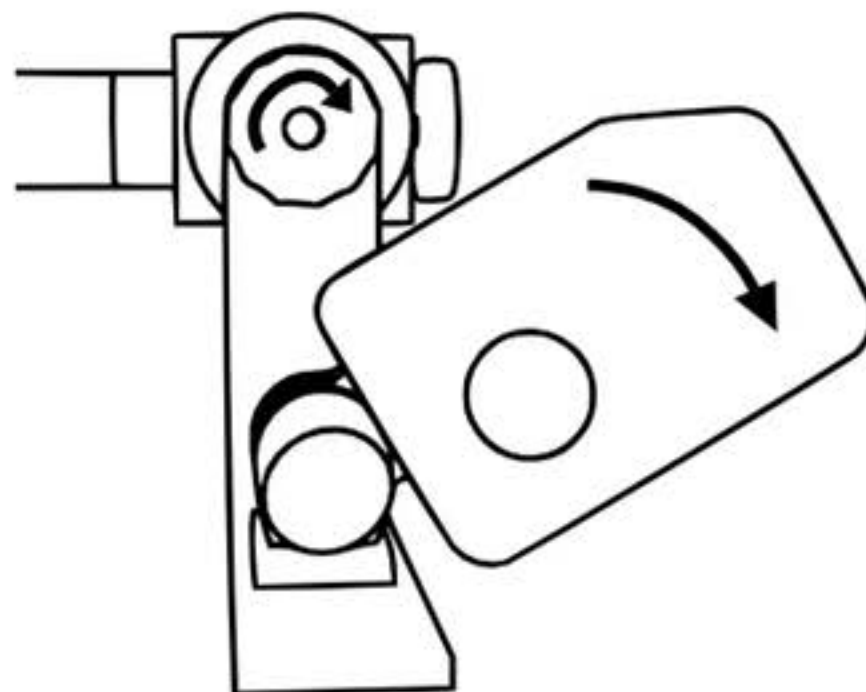

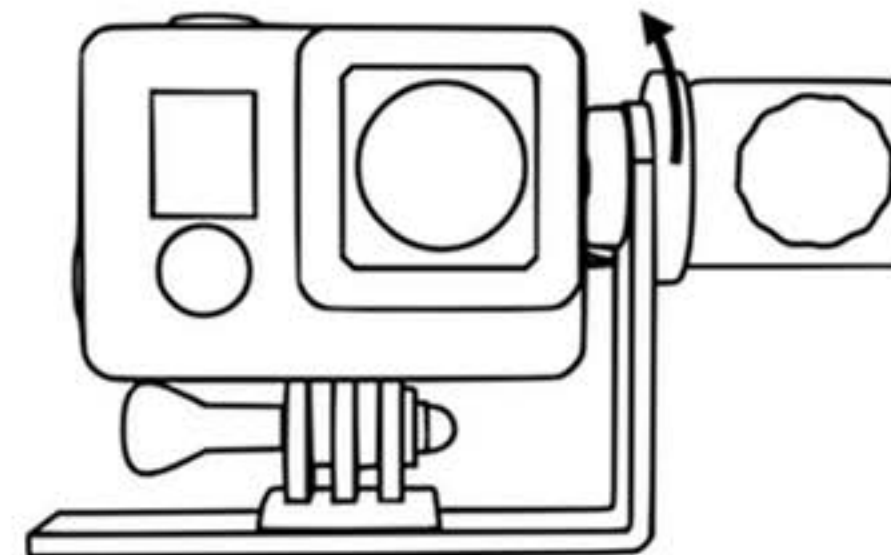
3. Tilting Setup



1. Remove silver tilt nut fastener and store safely. Leave gold tilt nut in L-Bracket hole.



2. Lean camera forward for easier access to tilt nut. Tighten Tilt Nut by turning clockwise onto gear shaft. turn until L-bracket is pushed against Locking nut.



3. Secure for tilting by turning locking nut counter-clockwise so that L-Bracket is firmly secure between Tilt Nut and Locking nut. Then reposition camera to desired position.

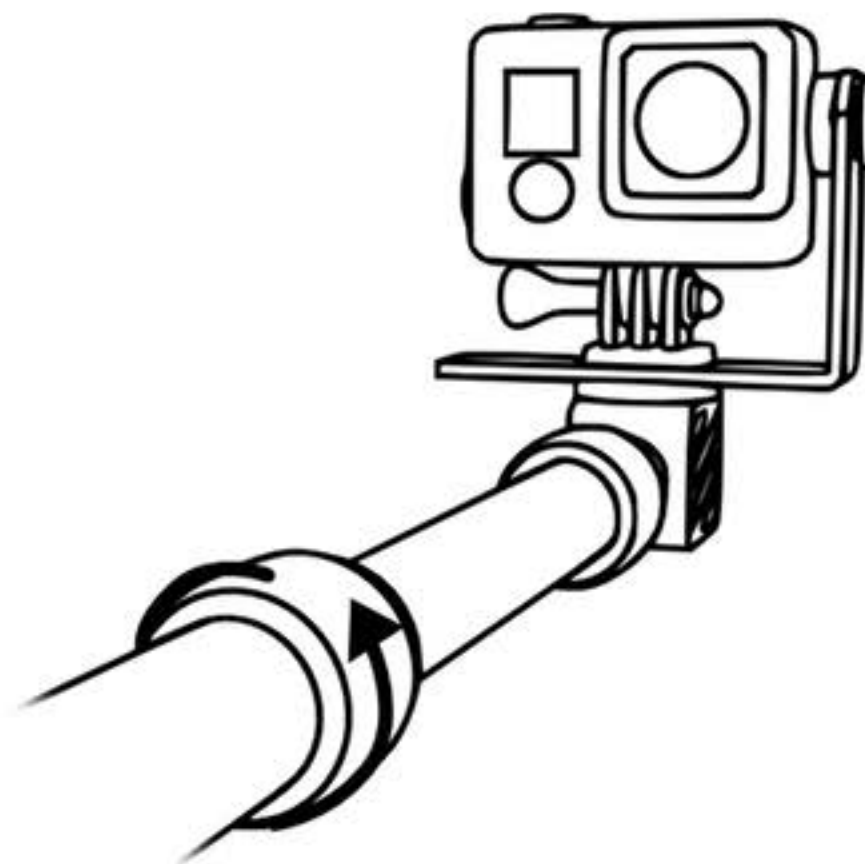

4. Extending MicroJib



1. While holding shaft turn either Twist Lock clockwise for $1/2$ of a rotation to loosen and allow for extension.
DO NOT OVER-LOOSEN



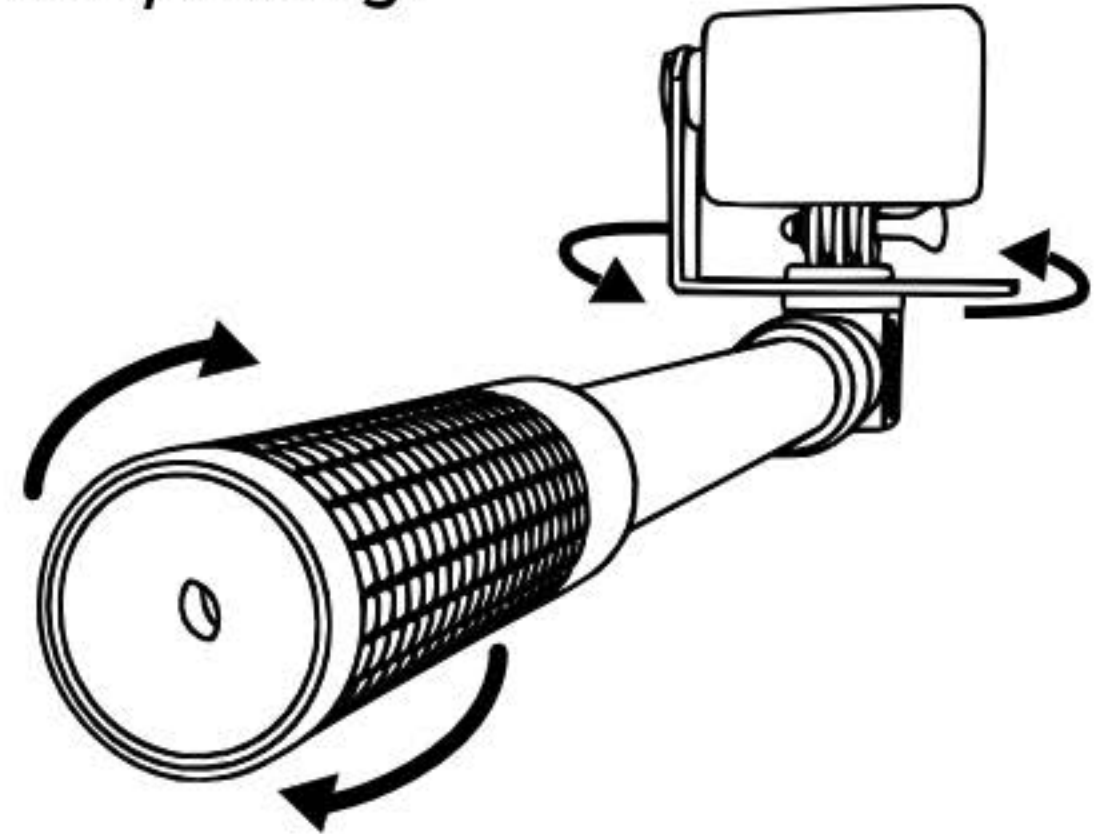
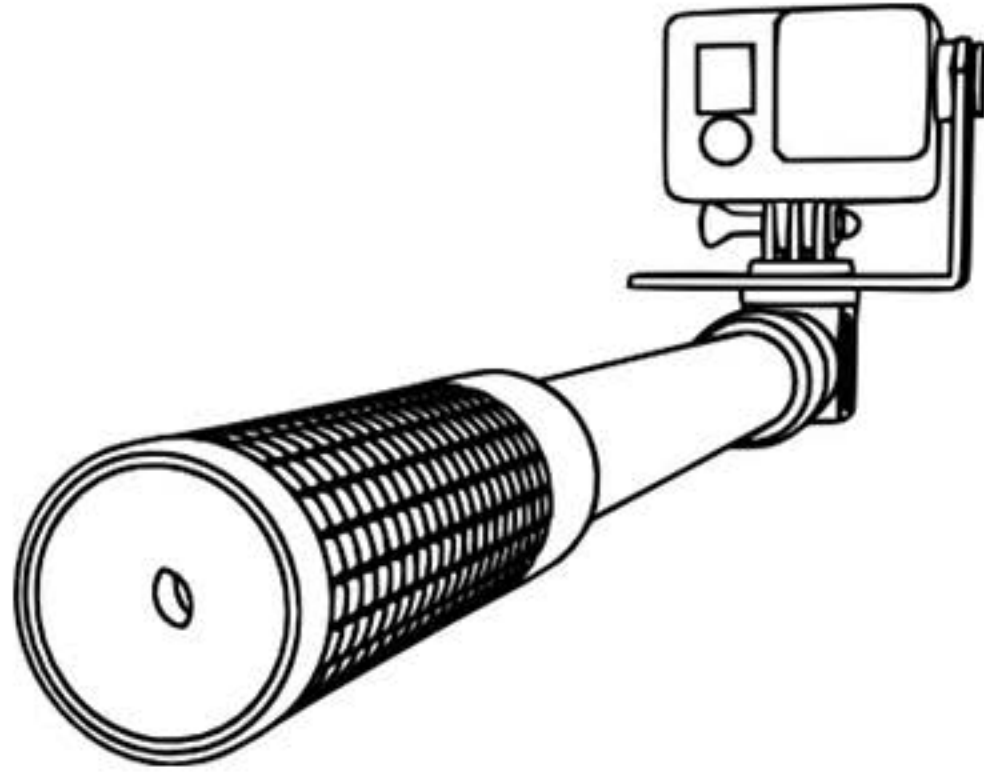
2. Extend shaft segment to desired length. Then turn loosened Twist Lock counter clockwise to secure in place. Repeat for alternate twist lock if desired.

5. Rotating Camera

**applies for both tilting and panning.*

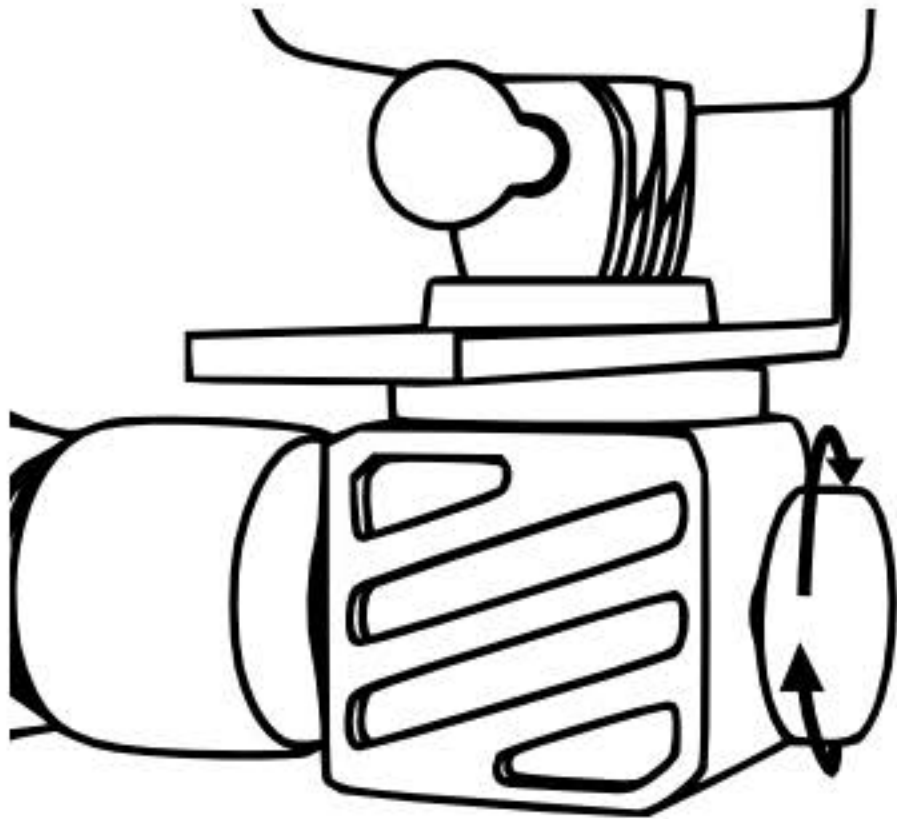


1. Before operating MicroJib make sure that locking screw (located at the front) is NOT tightened and thus will allow for rotation.
2. While holding shaft turn handle in desired direction. A 180 degree clockwise turn of the handle will result in a 180 degree counter-clockwise turn of camera.

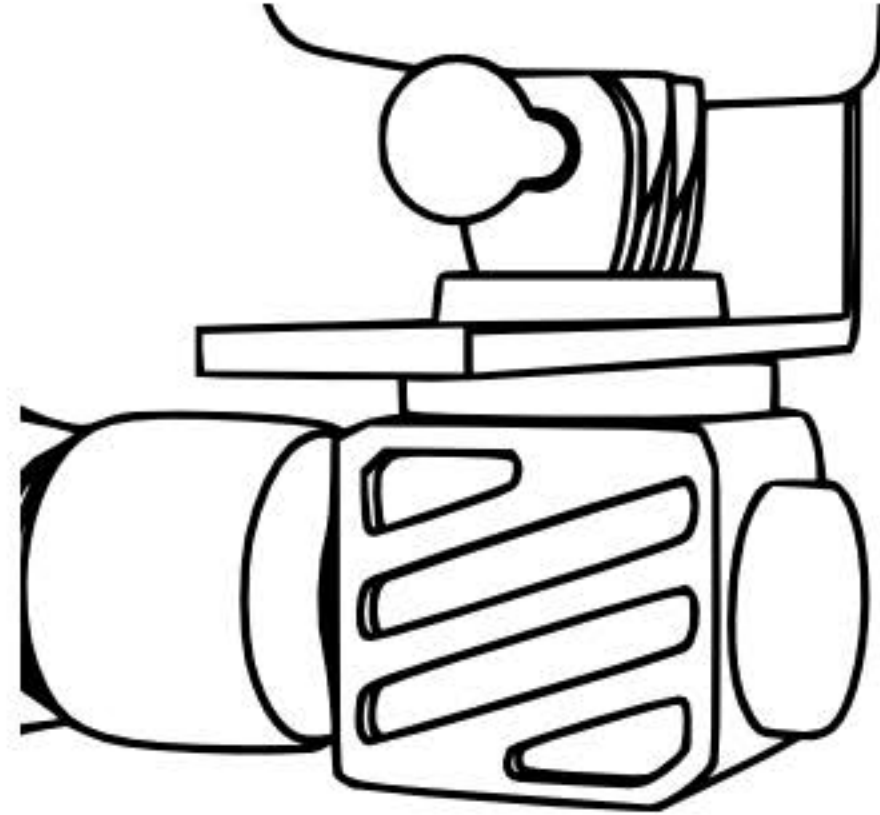

6. Locking MicroJib



1. Lock your camera in any position by simply turning gold locking screw at front of MicroJib clockwise until firm contact is made with gear shaft.



2. Once camera is locked DO NOT try to rotate camera by turning handle. This could damage your MicroJib. Always check that locking screw is loosened before rotating camera.

Camera Movements

There are infinite ways to utilize the MicroJibs functionality to create unique camera movements. That being said here are a few suggestions of different techniques to keep in mind while filming.

While Setup for Panning

1. Try moving the MicroJib laterally from side to side while simultaneously rotating the camera. Focus on the camera staying pointed at your subject.
2. Try starting with the camera pointed at yourself with a favorable landscape behind you (i.e. a city scape). Turn your body around in a full circle while simultaneously rotating your camera 360 degrees. The key to this motion is keeping your camera pointed at the landscape while you rotate your body.

QUICK TIP: When rotating the handle use just the tips of your fingers on the end of the handle. This provides a greater range of rotation.

Camera Movements (Continued)

While Setup for Tilting

1. Try holding the handle firmly in your bottom hand, while rotating the shaft. this should flip the camera from pointed straight forward to back towards yourself. Never miss a selfie opportunity.
2. To get a cool cinematic like crane shot start with your camera low to the ground and angled up. Next raise the MicroJib as high as you can while rotating the camera so it is pointed down towards your subject. Also try this the opposite way by starting with your camera high and finishing low.

QUICK TIP: When changing angle while tilting be smooth in your transition between the different camera angles. Try and focus on where the camera is pointed as you adjust the angle. After adequate practice you should develop a better feel for where the camera is pointed, even without looking.
